

SOMERSET AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT MOVES \$10 AUGUST TAX BILL MAILING TO FEBRUARY

The \$10 per capita tax bill that usually arrives in August is rescheduled for mailing in February 2018, as the Somerset Area School District moves to a new tax collector, Keystone Collections Group.



The District is transitioning to Keystone Collection Group on January 1, 2018 to improve the billing system and make the process easier for residents. The new tax collector will allow residents to pay online, speak with a live person to answer questions on every business day of the year and give our residents 24/7 access to an improved system.

In years past, the school district asked its former collector to mail per capita tax bills in August and occupation assessment tax bills in February. Beginning in 2018, the \$10 per capita tax and the \$10 occupation tax will be on one bill. The combined tax bills will arrive in February and will be administered by Keystone Collections Group. Keystone is a Pennsylvania municipal tax administrator operating in 21 counties across the Commonwealth, including collecting taxes in neighboring Bedford and Westmoreland counties.
